

Reading By Sound

Use the 10 new words from the Reading By Sight lesson

- Make a list of ending sounds (3-5) from the words used in the reading by sight lesson to reference
- Have child build one word from the previous reading by sight lesson
- Have child take away the first sound and ask what remains (physically remove the first letters of the word for a visual) You may help if needed.
- Have child come up with a new word using the ending sound by adding a new beginning sound (make sure the ending spells and sounds the same as the initial word used. Introduce blends when possible)
- Add the new words to the blackboard
- Have the child read the new column of words backwards and forwards
- Repeat with remaining words learned during reading by sight lesson from your list of ending sounds
- Dictate 2-5 ways for your child to arrange the new words (make complete sentences- may need to add 'is' or 'and' or 'the', ect. in the word box)
- Allow the child to make own arrangement of words into complete sentences if interested
- Add new words to child's word notebook (you'll probably be able to add 10 new words for each ending sound used!)
- Review when necessary!
