Reading By Sound

Use the 10 new words from the Reading By Sight lesson

Make a list of ending sounds (3-5) from the words used in the reading by sight lesson to reference
Have child build one word from the previous reading by sight lesson
Have child take away the first sound and ask what remains (physically remove the first letters of the word for a visual) You may help if needed.
Have child come up with a new word using the ending sound by adding a new beginning sound (make sure the ending spells and sounds the same as the initial word used. Introduce blends when possible)
Add the new words to the blackboard
Have the child read the new column of words backwards and forwards
Repeat with remaining words learned during reading by sight lesson from your list of ending sounds
Dictate 2-5 ways for your child to arrange the new words (make complete sentences- may need to add 'is' or 'and' or 'the', ect. in the word box)
Allow the child to make own arrangement of words into complete sentences if interested
Add new words to child's word notebook (you'll probably be able to add 10 new words for each ending sound used!)
Review when necessary!
